RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING BICYCLE LANES ON INDUSTRIAL ROAD, IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF BELMONT

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 21207 et seq. and Section 7.80.010 of the San Mateo County Ordinance Code allow the Board of Supervisors to establish bicycle lanes in public rights-of-ways; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works recommends establishing Bike Lanes to support the flow of both vehicular and bicycle traffic; and

WHEREAS, property owners on adjacent blocks extending a minimum of 300 feet from the proposed bike lanes were notified of this proposal and no comments have been received to date; and

WHEREAS, this Board has reviewed and concurs with the recommendation of the Director of Public Works.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors.

Establish a bicycle land at the following locations:

- From centerline of Harbor Boulevard, traveling south along the western side
 of Industrial Road (Road #64) begin bike lane at 50 feet continuing for 360
 feet, to City/County limits.
- From Centerline of Harbor Boulevard traveling south along eastern side of Industrial Road (Road #64) begin bike lane at 210 feet continuing for 200 feet to City/County limits.
