**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING BICYCLE LANES ON INDUSTRIAL ROAD, IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF BELMONT**

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, California Vehicle Code Section 21207 et seq. and Section 7.80.010 of the San Mateo County Ordinance Code allow the Board of Supervisors to establish bicycle lanes in public rights-of-ways; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Public Works recommends establishing Bike Lanes to support the flow of both vehicular and bicycle traffic; and

**WHEREAS**, property owners on adjacent blocks extending a minimum of 300 feet from the proposed bike lanes were notified of this proposal and no comments have been received to date; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board has reviewed and concurs with the recommendation of the Director of Public Works.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the Board of Supervisors.

Establish a bicycle land at the following locations:

1. From centerline of Harbor Boulevard, traveling south along the western side of Industrial Road (Road #64) begin bike lane at 50 feet continuing for 360 feet, to City/County limits.
2. From Centerline of Harbor Boulevard traveling south along eastern side of Industrial Road (Road #64) begin bike lane at 210 feet continuing for 200 feet to City/County limits.
