**RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2020 GARBAGE AND RECYCLABLES COLLECTION
RATES FOR COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 8 (NORTH FAIR OAKS)**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, as the Governing Board of County Service Area No. 8 (CSA-8), that

WHEREAS, October 20, 2009, your Board adopted Resolution No. 070423 which approved a franchise agreement with Recology San Mateo County (RSMC) to provide services for the collection of recyclable materials, organic materials, and garbage from January 1, 2011, through December 31, 2020. On June 4, 2019, your Board adopted Resolution 076641 approving the amended and restated Recology Franchise Agreement for an additional 15-year term expiring on December 31, 2035; and

WHEREAS, RSMC began service in the SBWMA service area on January 1, 2011; and

WHEREAS, on January 29, 2019, this Board adopted Resolution No. 076372 setting the 2019 garbage and collection rates for CSA-8, effective January 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, on July 23, 2019 this Board adopted Resolution No. 076814, on the filing of the 2019-20 FY Garbage and Recyclables Collection Service Charges Report for County Service Area No. 8 (North Fair Oaks) based on the effective rates; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Office of Sustainability has recommended garbage and recyclables collection rates for the CSA-8 attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the Franchise Agreement with RSMC included the Recology Unscheduled Service Charges attached hereto as Exhibit B, that are specifically requested and are paid for by the ratepayer, adjusted annually based upon the Consumer Price Index, and are in addition to the base collection rates; and

WHEREAS, on December 10, 2019, this Board adopted Resolution No. 077130, setting February 11, 2020, at 10:00 a.m. as the time and place for a public hearing on the 2020 Garbage and Recyclables Collection Rates for CSA-8; and

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the State of California requires that written notice of any proposed new or increased fees or property related charges be provided by mail to the record owners of each parcel upon which the charges are proposed for imposition; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Office of Sustainability has had said notice of the public hearing published in a newspaper of general circulation and provided written notice of the proposed rates to the record owner of each parcel within CSA-8 in accordance with the requirements of Proposition 218.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:
Effective February 1, 2020, the garbage and recyclables collection rates for services provided pursuant to the Franchise Agreement for the CSA-8 are as set forth in Exhibit “A” to this Resolution, which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference.
