BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

RESOLUTION: A) CONSOLIDATING THE PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION, TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, MARCH 3, 2020, WITH ELECTIONS CALLED BY THE BRISBANE SCHOOL DISTRICT, BURLINGAME ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT, JEFFERSON UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT, LA HONDA-PESCADERO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT, PORTOLA VALLEY SCHOOL DISTRICT, SAN CARLOS SCHOOL DISTRICT, SAN MATEO UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT, CITY OF FOSTER CITY, AND THE EAST PALO ALTO SANITARY DISTRICT; AND B) AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY'S CHIEF ELECTIONS OFFICER TO RENDER SPECIFIED ELECTION SERVICES IN CONJUNCTION THEREWITH.

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, Sections 10400 through 10418 of the Elections Code authorize the consolidation of elections that are called to be held on the same day and in or within the same territory upon the order of the governing body or bodies calling the elections, the consolidation may be ordered by the County Board of Supervisors upon request, and the consolidated election shall be held in all respects as if it were one election, with the returns being canvassed by the County's Chief Elections Officer; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the East Palo Alto Sanitary District is required to hold regularly scheduled governing board elections, and the named jurisdiction has notified the County's Chief Elections Officer of the number of seats to be elected and the boundaries of the district, and the named jurisdiction is requesting an election as

more candidates have filed to run for office in the named jurisdiction than there are seats available; and

WHEREAS, absent other arrangements or applicable law, the costs of any school district election shall be borne by the school district holding the election pursuant to Section 5421 of the Education Code, and any city or district shall reimburse the County in full for the services performed by the County's Chief Elections Officer in accordance with Division 10 of the Elections Code; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the Board of Trustees of the Brisbane School District adopted Resolution 2019-2020, No. V, giving notice of holding a special election to be held on March 3, 2020, for the purpose of submitting a bond measure to District voters, and requesting the County's Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the District therefor; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the Board of Trustees of the Burlingame Elementary School District adopted Resolution 2019/20-16, giving notice of holding a special election to be held on March 3, 2020, for the purpose of submitting a bond measure to District voters, and requesting the County's Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the District therefor; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the Board of Trustees of the Jefferson Union High School District adopted Resolution No. 2019-2020/5, giving notice of holding a special election to be held on March 3, 2020, for the purpose of submitting a bond

measure to District voters, and requesting the County's Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the District therefor; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the Board of Trustees of the La Honda-Pescadero Unified School District adopted Resolution No. 19-20-04, giving notice of holding a special election to be held on March 3, 2020, for the purpose of submitting a parcel tax measure to District voters, and requesting the County's Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the District therefor; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the Board of Trustees of the Portola Valley School District adopted Resolution No. 20-2019, giving notice of holding a special election to be held on March 3, 2020, for the purpose of submitting a parcel tax measure to District voters, and requesting the County's Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the District therefor; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the Board of Education of the San Carlos School District adopted Resolution #6:19/20A, giving notice of holding a special election to be held on March 3, 2020, for the purpose of submitting a parcel tax measure to District voters, and requesting the County's Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the District therefor; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the Board of Trustees of the San Mateo Union High School District adopted Resolution No. 19-20-07, giving notice of holding a special election to be held on March 3, 2020, for the purpose of submitting a bond measure to

District voters, and requesting the County's Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the District therefor; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the City Council of the City of Foster City adopted Resolution No. 2019-103, giving notice of holding a special election to be held on March 3, 2020, for the purpose of determining whether or not Councilmember Herb Perez shall be recalled and, if so, who shall be elected to replace him, and requesting the County's Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the City therefor; and

WHEREAS, each of the aforementioned districts and city has requested their respective elections to be consolidated with March 3, 2020, Presidential Primary Election; and

WHEREAS, the County's Chief Elections Officer is agreeable to providing specified election services as duly requested and enumerated above in conjunction with the Presidential Primary Election to be held on Tuesday, March 3, 2020; and

WHEREAS, in consideration of the services and supplies to be provided by the County's Chief Elections Officer in conducting said election, the Brisbane School District, Burlingame Elementary School District, Jefferson Union High School District, La Honda-Pescadero Unified School District, Portola Valley School District, San Carlos School District, San Mateo Union High School District, City of Foster City, and the East Palo Alto Sanitary District will, as required by law, enter into separate agreements with the County's Chief Elections Officer to outline the services to be rendered and to reimburse the County for the costs of said services and supplies.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that (A) the March 3, 2020 Presidential Primary Election is hereby consolidated with the above-named local elections duly called by their respective governing bodies; and (B) the County's Chief Elections Officer is authorized to render specified election services in conjunction therewith.
