RESOLUTION TO INSTALL STOP SIGNS ON SAN CARLOS AVENUE AT THE INTERSECTION OF MONTGOMERY AVENUE IN UNINCORPORATED REDWOOD CITY

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code sections 21351 through 21355 allow local authorities in their respective jurisdictions to install traffic signs as may be necessary to control traffic within an intersection; and

WHEREAS, the Department received requests to conduct a study at the intersection of San Carlos Avenue and Montgomery Avenue in unincorporated Redwood City; and

WHEREAS, staff investigated, conducted a study, and determined that installing an all-way stop control is warranted and would benefit the community; and

WHEREAS, the property owners on adjacent blocks, extending a minimum of 300 feet from the proposed stop signs were notified of the date and time of this Board's meeting when the item will be considered and comments received were in support of the four-way stop sign; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works is recommending installing two stop signs as noted herein; and

WHEREAS, this Board has reviewed and concurs in the recommendation of the Director of Public Works.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the

Board of Supervisors authorize:

Stop signs be established at the following locations:

Eastbound and westbound directions on San Carlos Avenue (Road No. 514) at the intersection with Montgomery Avenue (Road No. 506),
Sequoia Tract Area.
