JEFFERSON UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT FACULTY & STAFF HOUSING GROUNDBREAKING

WHEREAS, Jefferson Union High School District (JUHSD) in San Mateo County, State of California, is committed to providing quality education to its students; and

WHEREAS, the high cost of housing in the Bay Area may makes it difficult for the District to ensure that it is able to provide an adequate supply of teachers and other employees as needed to enable the District to continue to provide quality education to its students; and

WHEREAS, Board of Trustees of the District (the "Board") has determined that in order to recruit and retain high quality teachers and other employees of the District, it is advisable to provide affordable rental housing for such teachers and employees; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Teacher Housing Act of 2016, constituting Part 14 (commencing with Section 53570) of Division 31 of the Health and Safety Code of the State of California (the "Teacher Housing Act"), the State Legislature has found and declared that the stability of housing for school employees is critical to the overall success and stability of schools in California, and that students and the community at large are benefited by teachers living in the community in which they work; and

WHEREAS, the Teacher Housing Act authorizes a school district to establish and maintain programs that address the housing needs of teachers and school district employees;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of San Mateo County does hereby recognize and commends the JUHSD for the groundbreaking of their Faculty and Staff Housing.
