BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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RESOLUTION: A) ADOPTING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, INCLUDING CONFORMANCE WITH FEDERAL PREVAILING WAGE SCALE REQUIREMENTS, FOR THE PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE OF THE MADERA LANE BRIDGE PROJECT IN THE SAN GREGORIO AREA OF UNINCORPORATED SAN MATEO COUNTY; AND B) AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CALL FOR SEALED BIDS TO BE RECEIVED BY THURSDAY, APRIL 30, 2020 AT 2:30 PM IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY MANAGER/CLERK OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS; AND C) AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO EXTEND THE CALL FOR BIDS AND BID OPENING UP TO 60 CALENDAR DAYS BEYOND THE TIME AND DATE ORIGINALLY SET FORTH BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the California Department of Transportation's (Caltrans) Local Assistance Bridge Preventative Maintenance Program (Program) defines a process that local agencies can follow for bridge preventative maintenance projects to be eligible for federal funding; and

WHEREAS, the Department has complied with the Program requirements and identified the bridge preventative maintenance projects to proceed with for federal funding; and

WHEREAS, the Preventative Maintenance of the Madera Lane Bridge in the San Gregorio Area of San Mateo County Project (Project) consists of replacement of existing concrete girders and barrier railings, and repairing spalled concrete on the Madera Lane Bridge over El Corte de Madera Creek; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Highways Administration through Caltrans has

provided Federal Bridge Preventative Maintenance Program (BPMP) Funds for engineering and environmental services for this Project and will provide funding for the construction of the Project; and

WHEREAS, this Board adopted Resolution No. 075862 on April 24, 2018, which approved the plans and specifications, dated April 20, 2018, for the Preventative Maintenance of the Madera Lane Bridge in the San Gregorio Area of San Mateo County Project, and authorized the Department to issue a call for bids; and

WHEREAS, this Board adopted Resolution No. 075934 on June 5, 2018, which awarded the contract for the Preventative Maintenance of the Madera Lane Bridge in the San Gregorio Area of San Mateo County Project to Bugler Construction (Bugler); and

WHEREAS, after Bugler attempted to complete the work over the summers of 2018 and 2019, they requested to be released from their Contract in June 2019, which the Department subsequently authorized; and

WHEREAS, the Department has evaluated the options for the work required on the Madera Lane Bridge (Bridge) and is recommending that the originally proposed work on the Bridge be re-advertised; and

WHEREAS, the plans and specifications, dated March 20, 2020, for the Preventative Maintenance of the Madera Lane Bridge in the San Gregorio Area of San Mateo County Project have been prepared and approved by the Director of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the plans and specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established

by the U.S. Department of Labor on federally funded projects, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of worker needed to execute the contract; and

WHEREAS, this Board has considered and concurs with the recommendation of the Director of Public Works.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

1. The revised plans and specifications dated March 20, 2020, for the Preventative Maintenance of the Madera Lane Bridge in the San Gregorio Area of San Mateo County Project are hereby approved and are adopted as the plans and specifications to be adhered to in letting and performing the work under a contract for said improvements.
2. Said specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the U.S. Department of Labor on federally funded projects, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of worker needed to execute the contract.
3. The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to issue a call for sealed proposals and to set the bid opening date and time on or before 2:30 p.m., Thursday, April 30, 2020 in the office of the County Manager/Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in the Hall of Justice, Redwood City, California. Said bids will be received by the Deputy Clerk of the Board

of Supervisors and then transmitted to the County Manager's Office in said Hall of Justice and be publicly opened and declared.

4. The Director of Public Works is authorized to extend the call for bids and bid opening up to sixty (60) calendar days beyond the time and date originally set forth by the Board of Supervisors.
5. The Department of Public Works is further directed to cause the Notice inviting sealed bids to be published for three (3) times in a newspaper receiving wide local circulation, published in the County, and to obtain an affidavit of said publication, a copy of which shall be placed on file with the Department of Public Works.

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
