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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING COUNTY HEALTH, ON BEHALF OF THE
COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT ALL AVAILABLE
HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE PROGRAM FUNDS FROM THE
CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCES, RECYCLING AND RECOVERY
FOR TERM OF JULY 1, 2020 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2025**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo serves as the lead for all the incorporated cities for the Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) program; and

WHEREAS, Environmental Health Services (EHS) manages the program and ensures that HHW does not pose a threat to public health or the environment; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo serves as the lead for all the incorporated cities for the HHW program grants; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) grants help provide EHS with funding to provide important education and environmental protection programs for the public and the environment; and

WHEREAS, grantees are generally allowed a three-week turnaround to execute a grant agreement; and

WHEREAS, authorization is therefore being requested to allow the Chief of San Mateo County Health on behalf of the County to approve all necessary applications, contracts, payment requests, agreements, amendments and all documents necessary for the purposes of securing grant funds; implement the approved grant projects; and carry out the purposes specified in the grant applications for the period of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the grants will increase the HHW program's ability to inform the public of appropriate disposal options and pollution prevention alternatives and ensure that HHW does not end up in the landfills or water ways; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED that County Health is authorized to apply for and accept all available HHW program funds from CalRecycle beginning July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2025 through June 30, 2025.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief of San Mateo County Health, or designee, on behalf of the County, is hereby authorized to execute all necessary applications, contracts, payment requests, agreements, amendments, and documents necessary to secure grant funds to implement the approved grant projects and carry out the purposes specified in the grant applications beginning July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2025.

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
