RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH MODULAR SPACE CORPORATION CHANGING THE VENDOR'S NAME TO WILLIAMS SCOTSMAN INCORPORATED

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo authorized the procurement and installation of a new visitors Center at the Sanchez Adobe Park; and

WHEREAS, the new Sanchez Adobe Visitors' Center will enhance the educational experience for visitors who explore the former Mission Dolores Outpost (1786) and adobe residence (1842) of Don Francisco Sanchez; and

WHEREAS, on December 19, 2017, the County published a Request for Proposals for a 48 foot by 60 foot modular building and, on February 9, 2018, received a proposal from Modular Space Corporation in the amount of \$594,754; and

WHEREAS, on April 24, 2018 the Board approved an agreement with Modular Space Corporation for the modular building in the amount of \$594,794; and

WHEREAS, on August 7, 2018, the Board approved an amendment to the Modular Space Corporation agreement, recognizing additional items of work and establishing a not-to-exceed amount of \$733,272.

WHEREAS, subsequent to the execution of the agreement with Modular Space Corporation, Williams Scotsman Incorporated purchased Modular Space Corporation, fully assuming its assets and obligations; and

WHEREAS, County Counsel has reviewed and approved the Resolution as to form.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of the Board of Supervisors is authorized to execute an amendment to the agreement with Modular Space Corporation changing the vendor's name to Williams Scotsman Incorporated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Project Development Unit or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.
