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RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ROAD PROJECT LIST TO BE FUNDED WITH THE SENATE BILL 1 ROAD MAINTENANCE AND REHABILITATION ACCOUNT FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our County are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the County must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed start and completion schedule of the work being funded with RMRA funds, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the County, is estimated to receive \$11,129,265 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2020-21 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the fourth year in which the County is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the County to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation

projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the County used a Pavement Management System, which maintains the road network Pavement Condition Index (PCI), to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects while meeting the communities' priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the County maintain and rehabilitate the County-maintained roads, bridges, and infrastructure throughout the County this year and with similar projects in the future; and

WHEREAS, the 2018 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the County's streets and roads are at the borderline of "at risk" and "good" condition and this revenue will help us maintain or increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets and roads in a "good" condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.

- The list of proposed projects, as listed and attached hereto as Exhibit A, will be funded in-part or solely with FY 2020-21 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues.
- 3. The list of previously proposed and adopted projects, as listed and attached hereto as Exhibit A, may utilize FY 2020-21 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues in their delivery. With the relisting of these projects in the adopted fiscal year resolution, the County is reaffirming to the public and the State our intent to fund these projects with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues.
- 4. The FY 2020-2021 SB 1 Project list attached as Exhibit "A", hereto, is adopted by this Board as the list of projects to be funded with the Senate Bill 1 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account funds, which includes FY 2019-2020 SB 1 funded projects that will span into FY 2020-2021 and FY 2020-2021 SB 1 funded projects.

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
