Attachment "A – No Parking Zone on Lakeview Way

Adopt a resolution authorizing the establishment of a "No Parking Zone" at 951 Lakeview Way, Unincorporated San Mateo County.

Discussion:

- 1. A resident of Emerald Lake Hills submitted a Parking Restriction Request to the Department of Public works to restrict parking on Lakeview Way near a sharp turn citing limited sight distance and a narrow travel path at this location when vehicles are parked.
- 2. The applicant, who is not the property owner of the address where parking restriction is proposed, was put in contact with the Owner to discuss the issue, and possible solutions.
- 3. The Applicant and Property Owner discussed the situation and agreed to a fifty (50.0') foot "No Parking" zone. This agreed upon area is smaller than originally proposed at one hundred fifty (150') feet; preserving as much street parking as possible and allowing for greater sight distance and vehicle clearance.
- 4. A survey was mailed out to residents within a 300 ft radius of proposed "No Parking" zone to gain insight, and to understand whether the community supports this action. Those not in favor stated the originally proposed one hundred fifty (150.0') was too large of a space to restrict. Consequent proposals from feedback have resulted in a fifty

(50.0') foot proposed zone.
