RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A 30-FOOT ADA ACCESSIBLE PARKING ZONE ON NOTTINGHAM AVENUE IN UNINCORPORATED REDWOOD CITY

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Sections 22507 et. al. and Section 7.44.010 of the County of San Mateo Ordinance Code allow the Board of Supervisors to establish ADA accessible parking zone locations; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has recommended that a 30-foot ADA Accessible parking zone be established at 80 Nottingham Avenue in Redwood City; and

WHEREAS, Department staff evaluated this request and determined that the recommended parking restriction will not adversely affect the community; and,

WHEREAS, this Board has reviewed and concurs with the recommendation of the Director of Public Works.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that:

1. An ADA Accessible Parking Zone is established at the address of 80 Nottingham Avenue, Redwood City, on the southerly side of Nottingham Avenue (Road# 370)

commencing at approximately 200 feet southwest of the centerline of Marlborough Avenue (Road# 338) and extending southwesterly on Nottingham Avenue 30 feet, more or less.

2. The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to post any necessary signs and pavement markings.
