Proposed Parking Restrictions and Public Input Summary

Adopt resolutions authorizing the establishment of a “No Parking Zone” on Skyline Boulevard and “Time Limited Parking” zone, on portions of Crystal Springs Road and Skyline Boulevard, in Unincorporated San Mateo County.

Location: Portions of Skyline Boulevard and Crystal Springs Road, Unincorporated San Mateo County

Discussion:

The Department has evaluated the request and determined that a “No Parking” zone on Skyline Boulevard, and a “Time Limited Parking Zone from 10PM to 5AM” on portions of Skyline Boulevard and Crystal Springs Road is appropriately needed.

Key Facts:

- Staff has received a request from the Sheriff’s Office to restrict parking on portions of Crystal Springs Road and Skyline Boulevard due to address public nuisance in the form of trash, debris, illegal dumping and illegal activities.
- Crystal Springs Dam and the Sawyer Camp Trail is a popular weekday and weekend destination. Therefore, Time Limited restrictions are needed for overnight parking.
- Overnighters often park on shoulders on Crystal Springs Road and Skyline Boulevard in patterns that endanger pedestrians, bicyclists, and motorists traveling through the area.
- Stakeholders affected by this resolution were notified and concurred with the recommendations. The stakeholders are: Town of Hillsborough, Silicon Valley Bicycle Coalition, County of San Mateo Parks Department, San Francisco Water Department, and the California Highway Patrol (Redwood City Office).

Staff Recommendations:

Establish “Time Limited” and “No Parking” zones as shown on the attached maps.
