## BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A ONE-TIME GRANT OF DISTRICT-DISCRETIONARY MEASURE K FUNDS, NOT TO EXCEED \$100,000 TO CALIFORNIA CLUBHOUSE FOR PROGRAMS AND SERVICES FOR INDIVIDUALS LIVING WITH MENTAL ILLNESS, AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE GRANT AGREEMENT

**RESOLVED,** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, Measure K is the half-cent general sales tax initially approved by

San Mateo County voters in November 2012, and extended in November 2016 for a

total of thirty years; and

WHEREAS, the Board and County staff have conducted study sessions and

community outreach efforts to inform priorities for Measure K spending; and

WHEREAS, on February 12, 2019, the Board held a study session on Measure

K expenditures and anticipated revenue for fiscal years (FY) 2019-21, and approved the

allocation of \$3.75 million in one-time loans or grants each fiscal year for FY 2019-21,

divided equally among the supervisorial districts, for district-discretionary needs and projects; and

WHEREAS, Supervisorial District 3 and Supervisorial District 4 have requested a one-time \$100,000 grant to California Clubhouse for continued and evolving programs and services for individuals living with mental illness; and WHEREAS, this item is consistent with the criteria for district-discretionary Measure K funds approved by the Board in December 2018; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient Measure K funds in the Non-Departmental Services FY 2020-21 Recommended Budget for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, it is the Board's intent for the County Manager, or designee, to execute an agreement in the amount of \$100,000 grant to California Clubhouse and setting forth the terms of the grant in furtherance of the objectives set forth in the Project Summary section in this Board transmittal; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of the grant agreement and has examined it and approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into the agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the Board of Supervisors approves of said grant, and authorizes the County Manager, or his designee, to execute said grant agreement.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the County Manager or designee is authorized to execute amendments to the grant agreement which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than ten percent (10%) or \$25,000 (in aggregate), whichever is less, and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
