RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SAN CARLOS AND HALF MOON BAY AIRPORTS TO ACCEPT CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT (CARES ACT) GRANT FUNDS OFFERED BY THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA THROUGH THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION (FAA) TO HELP OFFSET A DECLINE IN REVENUES ARISING FROM DIMINISHED AIRPORT OPERATIONS AND ACTIVITIES AS A RESULT OF THE COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) passed by Congress and signed into law on March 27th, 2020; and

WHEREAS, The CARES Act included \$10 billion in funds to be awarded as economic relief to eligible U.S. airports affected by the prevention of, preparation for, and response to the COVID-19 pandemic. \$100 million of these funds were reserved for general aviation airports; and

WHEREAS, The San Carlos and Half Moon Bay Airports have received CARES Act relief fund grant offers in the amount of \$69,000 and \$30,000 respectively; and

WHEREAS, The Airports plan to use CARES Act funds to help offset reduced revenue due to decreased operations and additional expenses resulting from the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Director of Public Works or his designee is authorized to execute CARES Act grants on behalf of the County Airports.
