RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A "NO TRAILER PARKING" ZONE ON HUNTINGTON AVENUE IN THE NORTH FAIR OAKS AREA OF UNINCORPORATED REDWOOD CITY

**RESOLVED,** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 et al. and Section 7.28.070 of the County of San Mateo Ordinance Code allow this Board of Supervisors to prohibit or restrict the stopping, parking, or standing of vehicles or trailers by resolution or ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works received a Parking Restriction

Request to restrict trailer parking on Huntington Avenue in the North Fair Oaks area of unincorporated Redwood City; and

**WHERAS**, trailers occupy available on-site parking spaces and limit sight distance for other vehicles entering Huntington Avenue; and.

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has recommended that a "No Trailer Parking" zone be established as noted herein; and

**WHEREAS,** this Board has reviewed and concurs with the recommendation of the Director of Public Works.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS FURTHER DETERMINED AND ORDERED that:

- A "No Trailer Parking" zone be established at the following location:
   Huntington Avenue (Road No. 646), North Fair Oaks Area, between Pacific Avenue and Beresford Avenue.
- 2. The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to post any necessary signs and pavement markings.
