Proposed Parking Restrictions and Public Input Summary

Adopt a resolution authorizing the establishment of a "No Parking During Specified Hours" Monday through Friday, 7:30 A.M. to 9:30 A.M. and 2:00 P.M. to 4:00 P.M., Holidays Excluded" zone on Arlington Way in unincorporated Menlo Oaks.

Location: Arlington Way, unincorporated Menlo Oaks

Discussion:

- A signed petition was received from fifteen (15) residents on Arlington Way to restrict parking during specified hours to discourage loitering, littering, and obstruction of pedestrian travel paths.
- The proposal calls to restrict the parking of vehicles during specified hours to encourage students to park on campus.
- This restriction is designed to align with nearby Menlo Oaks Drive and Coleman Avenue that have the same time restrictions in place.



- Will improve overall safety / walkability
