RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH THE SOCIAL CHANGERY, LLC FOR A YOUTH MARIJUANA EDUCATION CAMPAIGN, ALCOHOL AND TOBACCO PREVENTION SERVICES, AND COVID-19 YOUTH EDUCATION, EXTENDING THE TERM OF THE AGREEMENT THROUGH JUNE 30, 2021 AND INCREASING THE AMOUNT BY \$446,960 TO AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$546,960

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, on April 21, 2020, the Chief of San Mateo County Health approved an agreement with The Social Changery, LLC to develop youth-oriented messaging and education materials, and conduct a media/marketing campaign informing youth about the impacts of COVID-19 for the term April 6, 2020 through June 30, 2020, in an amount not to exceed \$100,000; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to the Board of Supervisors for its consideration and acceptance an amendment to the agreement, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars, whereby The Social Changery, LLC will develop and place cannabis education messages, place tobacco prevention ads, and develop COVID-19 outreach materials, extending the term of the agreement through June 20, 2021, and increasing the amount by \$446,960 to an amount not to exceed \$546,960; and

WHEREAS, the Board has been presented with the amendment and has approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into the amended agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said amendment to the agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief of San Mateo County Health or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.
