# **Goal of County Testing Plan**

In combination with case and contact investigation, to detect as many of the positive cases in the County as feasible as early as possible so that effective local mitigation strategies can be initiated to contain the spread of the virus in our community.

#### **Three Core Strategies**

- Increase Testing Capacity to Support Comprehensive Case and Contact Investigation
- 2. Support strategic community testing
- 3. Ensure equitable access to testing

# **Three Core Strategies Cont'd**

Increase Testing Capacity to Support Comprehensive Case and Contact Investigation

- Enhance processing capacity of the Public Health Lab
- Create field testing teams

# **Three Core Strategies Cont'd**

Support strategic community testing

- Targeted testing of sites identified through investigation
- Congregate care settings
- Homeless population

# **Three Core Strategies Cont'd**

Ensure equitable access to testing

- Rotating Verily test site
- Public information campaigns
- Field testing
