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### RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE SAN MATEO COUNTY PARKS DEPARTMENT FEE SCHEDULE TO ELIMINATE THE VEHICLE ENTRANCE FEE AT FLOOD COUNTY PARK

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**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, Flood County Park (“Flood Park”) is a 21-acre municipal County-owned and -operated park located in the City of Menlo Park, which primarily serves residents from Menlo Park, North Fair Oaks, East Palo Alto, and Redwood City; and

**WHEREAS**, Flood Park is popular for its playgrounds, picnic sites, reservation sites, sports fields and courts, and open grassy area; and

**WHEREAS**, Flood Park is the only municipal park in southern San Mateo County that charges for vehicle access; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department proposes to eliminate the vehicle entrance fee at Flood Park in an effort to make access to greenspace and parks more equitable; and

**WHEREAS**, in FY 2018-19, Flood Park served approximately 114,200 visitors, and generated \$79,918 in revenue from vehicle entrance fees; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 2.63.020 of the County Ordinance Code, at its June 2020 meeting, the Parks Commission voted unanimously to recommend to the Board of Supervisors that the vehicle entrance fee at Flood Park be eliminated.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the Board of Supervisors, by adoption of this Resolution, authorize an amendment to the San Mateo County Parks Department Fee Schedule to eliminate the vehicle entrance fee at Flood County Park.

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
