**BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO MASTER SALARY  
RESOLUTION 077624 TO RECLASSIFY THREE POSITIONS; AND ACCEPT THE  
UPDATED REPORT OF BIWEEKLY SALARIES BY CLASSIFICATION.**

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, section 206a(4) of the San Mateo County Charter authorizes the Board of Supervisors to establish the number of all appointed officers and employees; and

**WHEREAS**, sections 206a(5) and 508 of the San Mateo County Charter authorize the Board of Supervisors to establish by ordinance or resolution the compensation and benefits of County officers and employees; and

**WHEREAS**, San Mateo County Ordinance No. 07303 ordered that henceforth the number of County appointed officers and employees and their compensation and benefits shall be established by resolution of the Board of Supervisors; and

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Board of Supervisors authorizes an amendment to Master Salary Resolution 077624 as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Part 14 of the Resolution is amended as indicated:

**ORGANIZATION 66000 SAN MATEO MEDICAL CENTER**

1. Item F009S, Patient Care Series is decreased by 1 position for a new total of 382 positions.

2. Item F008, Supervising Nurse Practitioner increased by 1 position for a new total of 2 positions.
3. Item E415, Patient Services Supervisor is decreased by 1 position for a new total of 16 positions.
4. Item G243S, Program Coordinator Series is increased by 1 position for a new total of 9 positions.
5. Item V264, IS Business Analyst I is increased by 1 position for a new total of 1 position.
6. Item G243S, Program Coordinator Series is decreased by 1 position for a new total of 8 positions.

**SECTION 2: Effective Date**

1. The changes in Section 1, Items 1 and 2 are effective retroactive to August 9, 2020.
2. The change in Section 1, Items 3 and 4 are effective retroactive to January 27, 2019.
3. All other changes are effective on the first pay period following adoption.

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
