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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH PENINSULA FAMILY SERVICE TO PROVIDE SENIOR PEER COUNSELING SERVICES AND HELP@HAND PEER-LED OUTREACH AND ENGAGEMENT FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2020 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2022, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$986,784

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Board has been asked to waive the Request for Proposals

(RFP) process in order to contract with Peninsula Family Service (PFS) for the provision of senior peer counseling services; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it is in the best interest of the County to waive the RFP process because of the effects COVID-19 has had on Behavioral Health and Recovery Services ability to run a fair and open bid process, not only in San Mateo County but in the other participating counties as well; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to the Board of Supervisors for its consideration and acceptance an Agreement, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars, whereby PFS shall provide senior peer counseling services and Help@Hand peer-led outreach and engagement for the period July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2022, for a maximum obligation of \$986,784; and

WHEREAS, the Board has been presented with the Agreement and has approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the

President of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief of San Mateo County Health or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
