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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH BAYSCAPE LANDSCAPE MANAGEMENT EXTENDING THE TERM TO NOVEMBER 30, 2021 AND INCREASING THE AMOUNT BY \$255,000 FOR A NEW NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$1,072,976

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works, Facilities Maintenance and Operations (Department) is authorized to engage the services of landscape maintenance and repairs; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 077594 authorized an agreement with Bayscape

Landscape Management to provide landscape maintenance and repair services for 36

County facilities and/or locations; and,

WHEREAS, on February 26, 2018, Amendment No. One added the Maple Street Homeless Shelter to the service list for landscape maintenance and repair services; and

WHEREAS, the Department added the Animal Shelter and the North Fair Oaks
Parking Lot to the facilities maintenance inventory for landscaping maintenance and
repair services; and

WHEREAS, the Department has added under Resolution 075594 Animal Shelter and the North Fair Oaks Parking Lot to the facilities maintenance inventory with the expectation of providing landscaping maintenance and repair services; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the agreement to extend the term date to November 30, 2021 and increasing the amount by \$255,000 for a new not to exceed amount of \$1,367,976; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of said Amendment and has examined and approved same as to both form and content, and desires to execute into said amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized and directed to execute said amendment to the agreement with Bayscape Landscape Management, increasing the maximum fiscal obligation by \$255,000 to a new, not-to-exceed amount of \$1,072,976, and extending the term to November 30, 2021.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the Director of Public Works or his designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and /or services so long as the modified term or services is / are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
