RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO SUBMIT ANNUAL GRANT APPLICATIONS AND EXECUTE GRANT AGREEMENTS WITH THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR THE VICTIM/WITNESS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR THE PERIODS OF OCTOBER 1, 2020 TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2021, OCTOBER 1, 2021 TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2022 AND OCTOBER 1, 2022 TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2023

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County District Attorney has applied for and has been awarded \$926,901 in grant funding from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services for the Victim/Witness Assistance Program for the period of October 1, 2019 to September 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County District Attorney desires to undertake the Victim/Witness Assistance Program to be funded by grant monies applied for and received from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services from the period of October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, each year, in order to apply for and receive such grant monies for such project, the County Board of Supervisors must approve the District Attorney's application for said grant and the execution of the related grant award agreement; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of efficiency, the San Mateo County District Attorney is requesting that this Board authorize the District Attorney's Office to apply for and

accept the above-reference grant monies through and including the period of October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2023; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board authorizes the District Attorney to submit annual grant proposals, execute grant agreements, and make any extensions and amendments thereof, with the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services for the Victim/Witness Assistance Program for providing comprehensive assistance to victims of crime through the period of October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2023 provided there will continue to be no cost to the County.
