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**RESOLUTION: A) RATIFYING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S GRANT APPLICATION AND EXECUTED AGREEMENT WITH THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR THE CHILD ADVOCACY CENTER PROGRAM FOR THE PERIOD OF APRIL 1, 2020 THROUGH MARCH 31, 2021; AND B) AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO SUBMIT ANNUAL GRANT APPLICATIONS AND EXECUTE SIMILAR AGREEMENTS WITH THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR THE CHILD ADVOCACY CENTER PROGRAM FOR PERIOD OF APRIL 1 2021 TO MARCH 31, 2022 AND APRIL 1, 2022 TO MARCH 31, 2023**

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**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, the San Mateo County District Attorney has applied for and has been awarded \$250,000 in grant funding from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services for the Child Advocacy Center Program for the period of April 1, 2020 through March 31, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the San Mateo County District Attorney desires to undertake the Child Advocacy Center Program to be funded by grant monies applied for and received from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services through April 1, 2021 to March 31, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, each year, in order to apply for and receive such grant monies for such project, the County Board of Supervisors must approve the District Attorney's application for said grant and the execution of the related grant award agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, in the interest of efficiency, the San Mateo County District Attorney is requesting that this Board authorize the District Attorney's Office to apply for and accept the above-reference grant monies through and including the period of April 1, 2021 to March 31, 2023; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the Board of Supervisors hereby ratifies the District Attorney's application for a grant and execution of the grant agreement with the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services for the Child Advocacy Center Program for the period of April 1, 2020 through March 31, 2021; and authorizes the District Attorney to submit annual grant proposals and to execute any agreements to make any extensions and amendments thereof, to the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services for the Child Advocacy Center Program for providing comprehensive assistance to victims of crime through the period of April 1, 2021 to March 31, 2023.

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
