**BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

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**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SANTA CRUZ AVENUE AND ALAMEDA DE LAS PULGAS IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT AND SUPPORTING AN APPLICATION TO THE SAN MATEO COUNTY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY FOR PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE PROGRAM FUNDING**

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**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, the County of San Mateo Department of Public Works (Department) has identified roadway improvements to the Santa Cruz Avenue and Alameda de las Pulgas Corridor to improve safety for drivers, bicyclists, and pedestrians using the corridor; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Sponsor has developed the Santa Cruz Avenue and Alameda de las Pulgas Improvements Project (Project) to increase visibility, provide crosswalk improvements, dedicated buffered bicycle lanes, and sidewalks that meet current Americans with Disability Act (ADA) standards; and

**WHEREAS**, it will cost \$6,000,000 to implement the Project scope; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department is seeking \$700,000 for the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the San Mateo County Transportation Authority (TA) issued a Call for Projects for the Measure A & W Pedestrian and Bicycle Program on August 7, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the Transportation Authority requires a governing board resolution from the Department for the following items:

1. Supporting the Project and application for \$700,000 in TA Pedestrian and Bicycle Program funds for Project, and
2. Committing the Sponsor to the completion of the Project, including the commitment of matching funds in the amount of \$250,000 needed for implementation, and
3. Certifying that any funds awarded by the San Mateo County Transportation Authority will be used to supplement existing funds for program activities and will not replace existing funds or resources.
4. Authorizing the chief executive of the Sponsor, or designee, to sign a funding agreement with the TA, if funds are awarded, for TA pedestrian and bicycle program funding for the Project and to take any other actions necessary to give effect to this resolution.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the Board of Supervisors.

1. Adopts the Santa Cruz Avenue and Alameda de las Pulgas Improvements Project.
2. Directs the County of San Mateo Public Works to submit an application for TA Measure A Pedestrian and Bicycle Program funds for \$700,000 for the Santa Cruz Avenue and Alameda de las Pulgas Improvements Project.
3. Authorizes the Public Works Director, or designee, to execute a funding agreement with the San Mateo County Transportation Authority to encumber any TA Pedestrian and Bicycle Program funds awarded.
4. Commits to the completion of the Project, including the commitment of \$250,000 of matching funds needed for implementation, if awarded the requested TA funds.
5. Certifies that any funds awarded by the San Mateo County Transportation Authority will be used to supplement existing funds for program activities

and will not replace existing funds or resources.

6. Take any other actions necessary to give effect to this resolution.

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
