Small Property Owner Assistance Program Update

November 10, 2020



Program Overview

- Cash grants of up to \$6,000 per rental unit for losses incurred April 1 August 31, 2020; maximum of 10 units per applicant
- In exchange for grant, property owner discharges renter's back-rent, up to a maximum discharge amount of \$7,500

Program Status (as of 4 November 2020)

- Outreach conducted continuously in English, Spanish, and Chinese since early October through County and partners
- 144 Registrations, 31 Submitted Applications, 6 Tentative Approvals
- Currently, only \$59K of \$2M appropriation is tentatively obligated
- Majority of tentative denials are for failure to meet the two incomebased applicant criteria

Property Owner Eligibility with Recommended Changes

- Live in San Mateo County
- Lease residential rental units in the county
- Rely on rent as primary income source
- Earned < \$400,000 annual gross rental income in both 2019 and 2018 (Loss to Income ratio will remain primary prioritization factor)

Rental Unit Eligibility

- Currently occupied by renters leasing the units for 30 days or more
- Lost rent due to nonpayment April August 2020
- No code violations or unaddressed public liens
- Rent < = 2020 HUD SMC Fair Market Rents (Units rented at or below FMR will be prioritized)

Funding Reallocation Provision

- Even with changes, unlikely to fully subscribe program even with changes
- CARES funding must be spent by 30 December 2020
- Added provision to allow County Manager to reallocate funds to other Board of Supervisors approved COVID-19 relief programs
