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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HIRING OF PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS' RETIRING 911 DISPATCHER II, DOROTHY CORDELL, PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE §7522.56(F)(1) AND FINDING THAT THE NATURE OF EMPLOYMENT IS NECESSARY TO FILL A CRITICALLY NEEDED POSITION DURING THE 180-DAY POST-RETIREMENT SEPARATION PERIOD

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, Dorothy Cordell will retire January 1, 2021 after serving in Public

Safety Communications (PSC) Department for over 21 years; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Cordell has years of experience working as an emergency 911

dispatcher, specializing in law dispatch and her skills are needed for continuity and

training new recruits; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Cordell will be employed as a Communications Dispatcher II-

Relief at a rate of \$52.88 per hour and would be limited to working a maximum of 960 hours each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Government Code §7522.56 requires a 180-day separation period as established by the California Public Pension Reform Act, before re-hiring or contracting with a retired employee unless the governing body makes a finding certifying that the appointment is necessary to fill a critically-needed position. NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors certifies, pursuant to Government Code §7522.56(f)(1), that the nature of the employment described above and the requested appointment is necessary to fill a critically-needed position in the Public Safety Communications Department before 180 days have passed given the facts outlined above, and accordingly approves the hiring of Dorothy Cordell, into an extra-help position upon her retirement.

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
