BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH FRESH APPROACH TO ESTABLISH AND OPERATE A NEW COMMUNITY COMPOSTING HUB AT THE PHOENIX GARDEN AND TO PROVIDE PUBLIC EDUCATION AND OUTREACH ABOUT COMPOSTING, INCREASING THE AMOUNT BY \$119,048 TO AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$431,678

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the County is proactively preparing for climate change, and there remains an urgent need to slow the production of greenhouse gases in California including methane generated from organic waste decomposition in landfills; and

WHEREAS, additional programming, public education, and outreach will help remove barriers that limit community members' participation in composting programs, resulting in an increase in organic waste recycling and reduction in landfill disposal; and

WHEREAS, CA SB 1383 requires that the County assess the composting capacity of community composting programs and, if necessary, identify opportunities for these programs to expand their operations; and

WHEREAS, the County aims to leverage as many partnerships and collaborations as possible with relevant organizations and cities in complying with CA

SB 1383 and expanding organics diversion programs such as community composting;
and

WHEREAS, on February 1, 2020, this Board, by Resolution No. 077219,
approved an agreement with Fresh Approach to provide public education and outreach
about food waste prevention and food preservation for the term of January 28, 2020
through June 30, 2022 for an amount not to exceed \$312,630; and

WHEREAS, by amending this agreement to add additional funds, Fresh
Approach will help establish and operate a new community composting program and
provide support and additional composting education and outreach at the Phoenix
Garden in San Mateo.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors shall be
and is hereby authorized and directed to execute the amendment to the Agreement with
Fresh Approach in an amount not to exceed \$431,678, and the Clerk of the Board shall
attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Office of Sustainability, or
the Director's designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the
County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate) and/or
modify the contract terms and/or services so long as the modified term of services is/are
within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
