RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING

Carr McClellan

In Celebration of its

75th Anniversary

WHEREAS, Carr McClellan was founded in July 1945 when Luther Carr joined with Ed Cosgriff to open a law practice in Burlingame, which would become the respected law firm of Carr, McClellan, Ingersoll, Thompson and Horn, and which is now known as Carr McClellan, and through 75 years of growth and change has continually served clients in San Mateo County, the greater Bay Area and beyond; and

WHEREAS, Carr McClellan attorneys helped organize the Peninsula Hospital District in 1947 providing legal services as Peninsula Hospital was envisioned, constructed and finally opened in 1954, assisted the San Mateo Union High School District with the acquisition of land to build Capuchino High School in San Bruno, helped guide the development of the town of Foster City; and

WHEREAS, the founders of Carr McClellan volunteered with Rotary, the Kiwanis, the American Legion, the Burlingame Chamber of Commerce, local school boards, and founded the San Mateo Chapter of the Reserve Officers of Naval Service to advocate for returning veterans, and served for decades as the city attorneys to the Town of Hillsborough; and

WHEREAS, Carr McClellan attorneys keep this tradition of community service alive today, and can be found serving in a variety of local organizations including Rotary International, HIP Housing, CASA of San Mateo County, the California Pacific Medical Center Foundation, the San Mateo Legal Aid Society, Elder Alliance, the San Francisco Maritime National Park Association and SAMCEDA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, hereby honors and commends Carr McClellan upon its 75th Anniversary.
