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RESOLUTION: A) AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF COMMUNITY SEREVICES BLOCK GRANT DISCRETIONARY FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY SERVICES AND DEVELOPMENT FUNDED THROUGH THE CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY (CARES) ACT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$40,370 FOR A NEW TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$674,332 FOR THE TERM OF MARCH 27, 2020 THROUGH MAY 31, 2022; AND B) AUTHORIZING THE HUMAN SERVICES AGENCY DIRECTOR OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE COUNTY'S EXISTING AGREEMENT WITH CSD TO ACCEPT AN ADDITIONAL \$40,370 IN COMMUNITY SERVICES BLOCK GRANT DISCRETIONARY FUNDING THROUGH THE CARES ACT FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY SERVICES AND DEVELOPMENT WITHIN THE GRANT PERIOD OF MARCH 27, 2020 THROUGH MAY 31, 2022

WHEREAS, in March of 2020, the Federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and

Economic Security (CARES) Act was signed in to law in response to the economic

fallout of the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Community Services and

Development (CSD) awards Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) funded by the

CARES Act to local Community Action Agencies to provide services to low-income

individuals in an effort to reduce poverty; and

WHEREAS, Human Services Agency (HSA), the Community Action Agency in

San Mateo County, was allocated an additional \$40,370 in CSBG CARES Act

discretionary funds to target needs in the community related to COVID-19 pandemic;

and

WHEREAS, HSA has received an amendment to the agreement with CSD to accept discretionary funds in the amount of \$40,370 for a new total grant amount of \$674,332 to charge expenditures incurred in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

## NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the

Board of Supervisors authorizes the acceptance of discretionary funds from the Community Services Block Grant Funding from the State of California Department of Community Services and Development funded through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act in the amount of \$40,370 for a new total grant amount of \$674,332 for the term of March 27, 2020 through May 31, 2022; and authorizes the Human Services Agency Director or designee to execute an amendment to the County's existing agreement with CSD to a accept an additional \$40,370 in Community Services Block Grant discretionary funding through the CARES Act from the State of California Department of Community Services and Development within the grant period of March 27, 2020 through May 31, 2022.

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
