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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A ONE-TIME GRANT TO AYUDANDO LATINOS A SONAR TO PROVIDE WATER TO FARMWORKERS FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$10,000, AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE GRANT AGREEMENT

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo,
State of California, that

WHEREAS, Ayudando Latinos A Sonar (ALAS) operates as a trusted County of San Mateo partner in Half Moon Bay distributing educational information, food, water, and personal protective equipment (PPE) to farmworkers and Latinx residents throughout the Coastside; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has disproportionately impacted lowincome rural communities of color like the San Mateo County farmworker community; and

WHEREAS, this highly impacted population is the primary recipient of ALAS relief; and

WHEREAS, ALAS has learned from their clients that many residents and farmworkers do not have consistent and stable access to potable water; and

WHEREAS, these essential workers of San Mateo County require additional assistance in order to follow COVID-19 safety guidelines and maintain their health while working; and

WHEREAS, ALAS has the capacity and knowledge to distribute water to members of the community in need; and

WHEREAS, it is the Board's intent for the County Manager, or designee, to execute an agreement in the amount of \$10,000 to ALAS and setting for the terms of the grant in furtherance of the objectives set forth in the Board transmittal; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of the agreement and has examined it and approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into the agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors approves of said grant, and authorizes the County Manager, or designee, to execute the agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Manager or designee is authorized to execute amendments to the grant agreement which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than ten percent (10%) or \$25,000 (in aggregate), whichever is less, and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
