BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING: A) THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO PROCEED WITH FINALIZING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, INCLUDING CONFORMANCE WITH FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS, FOR THE SCENIC DRIVE REPAIR AND RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT IN THE LA HONDA AREA OF UNINCORPORATED SAN MATEO COUNTY; AND B) THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO PROCEED WITH ADVERTISING FOR BIDS ON THE SCENIC DRIVE REPAIR AND RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT AND REPORT BACK TO THIS BOARD AND WITH RECOMMENDATIONS ON AWARDING A CONTRACT

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the impacted section of Scenic Drive is located adjacent to 331, 340, and 345 Scenic Drive, in the unincorporated area of La Honda, in San Mateo County; and

WHEREAS, the La Honda Area, like much of the County, suffered record rainfall during the 2016-2017 winter, and on January 11 and 12, 2017, the heavy rainfall caused an integral ground failure in the area; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the integral ground failure, Scenic Drive was closed at this location and the adjacent three residences were deemed uninhabitable and red-tagged; and

WHEREAS, the County, as a sub-applicant, applied for and was approved for Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) funding through the California Office of Emergency Services (CalOES); and

WHEREAS, the owners of 345 Scenic Drive chose to retain ownership of the property and 331 and 340 were purchased by the County under a FEMA Hazard

Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) funded project, which included work to demolish the homes and convert the parcels to open space as required by the HMGP; and

WHEREAS, on March 10, 2020, this Board adopted Resolution, No. 077294, which adopted plans and specifications and called for sealed bids for the Demolition and Disposal of Materials of Two Single Family Residences (331 and 340 Scenic Drive) in the La Honda Area Project; and

WHEREAS, on May 19, 2020, this Board adopted Resolution, No. 077446, which awarded an agreement with Resource Environmental, Inc. for the Demolition and Disposal of Materials of Two Single Family Residences (331 and 340 Scenic Drive) in the La Honda Area Project; and

WHEREAS, with the house demolition work completed, the restoration of Scenic Drive can proceed; and

WHEREAS, on February 19, 2021, FEMA, through CalOES, approved the design modifications (revised scope of work) and time extension requested by County; and

WHEREAS, FEMA requirements states that the County must refrain from construction activities until FEMA provides the environmental clearance for the revised scope of work; and

WHEREAS, County is continuing to work with FEMA to obtain the required environmental clearance before the Project can move towards construction; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has recommended that this Board authorize the finalization of the plans and specifications and call for bids for the Scenic Drive Repair and Reconstruction Project, once the FEMA requirements have been

satisfied, to shorten the time to award a contract and enable commencement of construction in the summer of 2021; and

WHEREAS, this Board has considered and agrees with the recommendations of the Director of Public Works.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that

1. The Director of Public Works is authorized to proceed with finalizing the plans and specifications for the Scenic Drive Repair and Reconstruction Project.
2. The Director of Public Works is directed to advertise for bids on the Scenic Drive Repair and Reconstruction Project, once the FEMA requirements have been satisfied, and to report to this Board with recommendations on awarding a contract to the lowest responsible bidder for said Project once bids are received and confirmed.
3. The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to issue a call for sealed bids to be published for three (3) times in a weekly local newspaper of general circulation, published in the County, and obtain and affidavit of said publication, a copy of which shall be placed on file with the Department of Public Works.
4. The Director of Public Works is authorized to extend the call for bids and bid opening up to sixty (60) calendar days beyond the time and date originally set forth by the Board of Supervisors.

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
