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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING: A) THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO PROCEED WITH FINALIZING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE GAZOS CREEK ROAD REPAIR PROJECT; AND B) THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO PROCEED WITH ADVERTISING FOR BIDS ON THE GAZOS CREEK ROAD REPAIR PROJECT AND REPORT BACK TO THIS BOARD WITH RECOMMENDATIONS ON AWARDING A CONTRACT

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, during the CZU Lightning Complex Fires that started on August 14, 2020, Gazos Creek Road was used for access by Cal-Fire’s fire fighting vehicles, trucks, and heavy equipment to suppress the wildfires and Gazos Creek Road sustained roadway damage; and

WHEREAS, the County applied to and received approval from the Federal Emergency Management Agency to receive disaster relief funding, to repair the damage to Gazos Creek Road, between Cloverdale Road and the end of Gazos Creek Road; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has recommended that this Board authorize the finalization of the plans and specifications and call for bids for the Gazos Creek Road Repair Project, to shorten the time to award a contract and enable commencement of construction in the Summer of 2021; and

WHEREAS, the specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the U.S. Department

of Labor on federally funded projects, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of workman needed to execute the contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that

1. The Director of Public Works is authorized to proceed with finalizing the plans and specifications for the for the Gazos Creek Road Repair Project.
2. The Director of Public Works is directed to advertise for bids on the Gazos Creek Road Repair Project and to report to this Board with recommendations on awarding a contract to the lowest responsible bidder for said Project once bids are received and confirmed.
3. The Director of Public Works is authorized to extend the call for bids and bid opening up to sixty (60) calendar days beyond the time and date originally set by the Director of Public Works.
4. The Department of Public Works is further directed to cause the Notice inviting sealed bids to be published for three (3) times in a weekly local newspaper of general circulation, published in the County, and obtain an affidavit of said publication, a copy of which shall be placed on file with the Department of Public Works.

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
