### RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A “NO PARKING DURING SPECIFIED HOURS FROM 9:00 PM TO 6:00 AM, MONDAY THROUGH SUNDAY” ZONE ON OLYMPIC WAY IN UNINCORPORATED DALY CITY

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 et al. and Section 7.32.010 of the County of San Mateo Ordinance Code allow the Board of Supervisors to establish parking zones and associated signs and markings in their respective jurisdictions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Public Works received a request to address illegal dumping and improve line-of-sight distance along this curve of Olympic Way in unincorporated Daly City; and

**WHEREAS**, property owners on adjacent blocks, extending a minimum of 300 feet from the proposed parking restriction zone were notified of this Board’s meeting and comments received to date in in favor of this change; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Public Works has recommended that a “No Parking during Specified Hours from 9:00 PM to 6:00 AM, Monday through Sunday” be established at Olympic Way in unincorporated Daly City, San Mateo County; and,

**WHEREAS**, this Board has reviewed and concurs with the recommendation of the Director of Public Works.

**IT IS FURTHER DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that:

1. “No Parking during Specified Hours of 9:00 PM to 6:00 AM, Monday through Sunday” zone, shall begin sixty (60.0’) feet west of the southbound intersection of Skyline Boulevard and Olympic Way along both sides of the road on Olympic Way (Road No. 185), a distance of four hundred thirty feet (430.0’) feet, more or less.
