RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HIRING OF RETIRED DEPUTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY JOHN WILSON PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 7522.56(f)(1) AND FINDING THAT THE NATURE OF EMPLOYMENT IS NECESSARY TO FILL A CRITICALLY NEEDED POSITION DURING THE 180-DAY POST-RETIREMENT SEPARATION PERIOD

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, John Wilson retired on January 29, 2021 after serving in the San

Mateo County District Attorney's Office for over 40 years; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Wilson has specialized skills in consumer fraud and

environmental crimes that are critical to consumer and environmental protection for the citizens of San Mateo County; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Wilson will be employed as a Deputy District Attorney at a rate of \$118.72 per hour and would be limited to working a maximum of 960 hours each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 7522.56 requires a 180-day separation period as established by the California Public Pension Reform Act before re-hiring or

contracting with a retired employee unless the governing body makes a finding certifying that the appointment is necessary to fill a critically needed position,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the

Board of Supervisors certifies, pursuant to Government Code section 7522.56(F)(1), that the nature of the employment described above and the requested appointment is necessary to fill a critically needed position in the District Attorney's Office before 180 days have passed given the facts outlined above, and accordingly approves the hiring of John Wilson into the extra-help position from which he retired on January 29, 2021.
