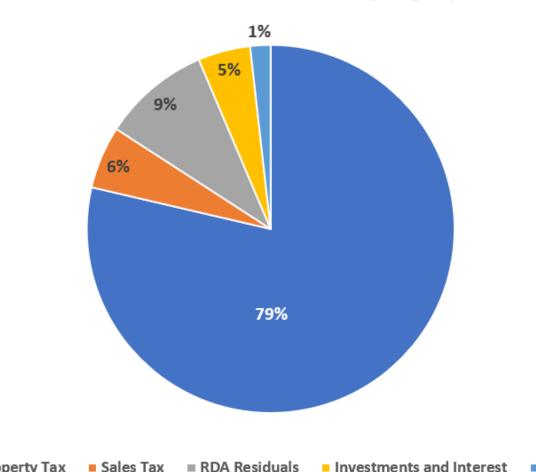

Timeline for Sales and Use Tax Fiscal Impact



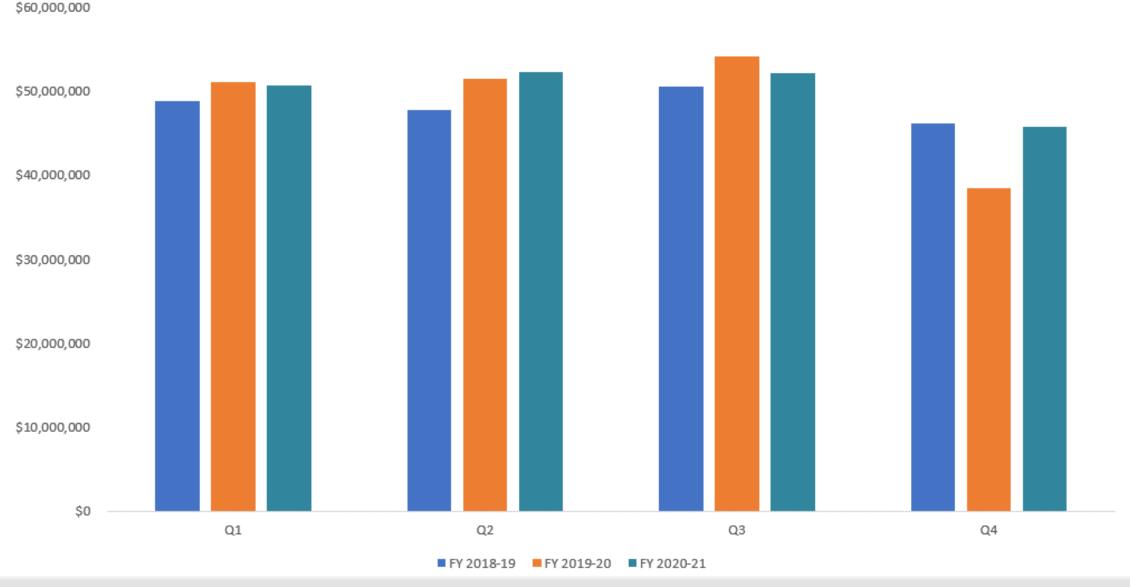
- Two-month lag in sales tax receipts

State Sales Tax Revenues





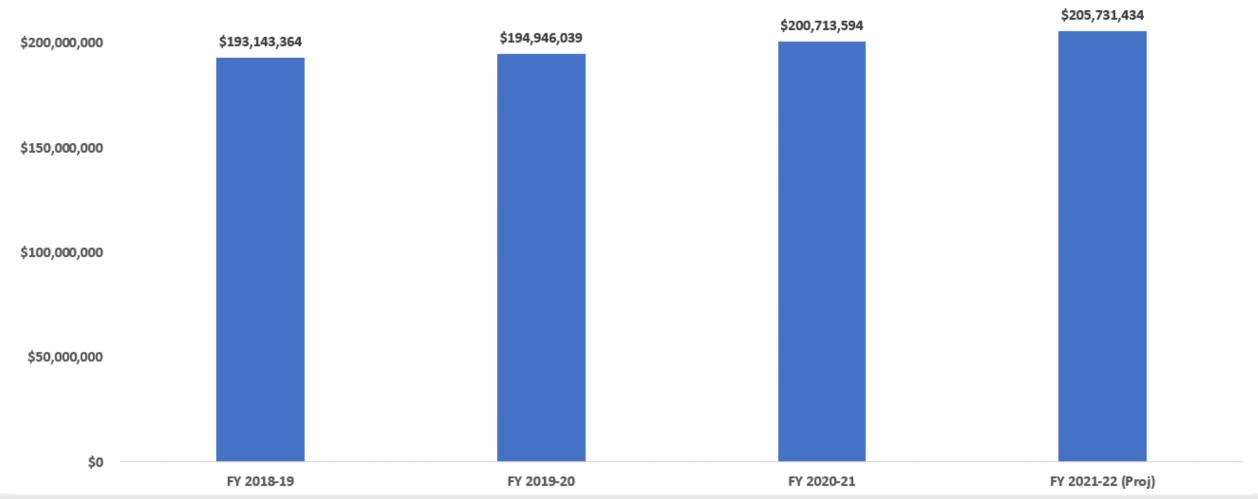

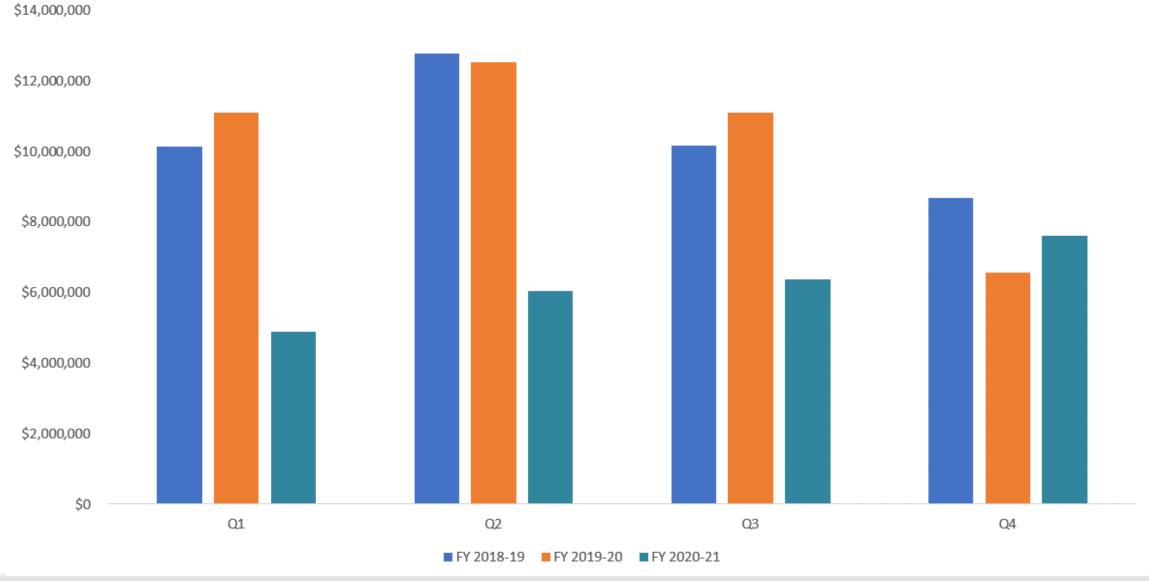
County Sales and Use Tax Revenue (Excludes Measure K)

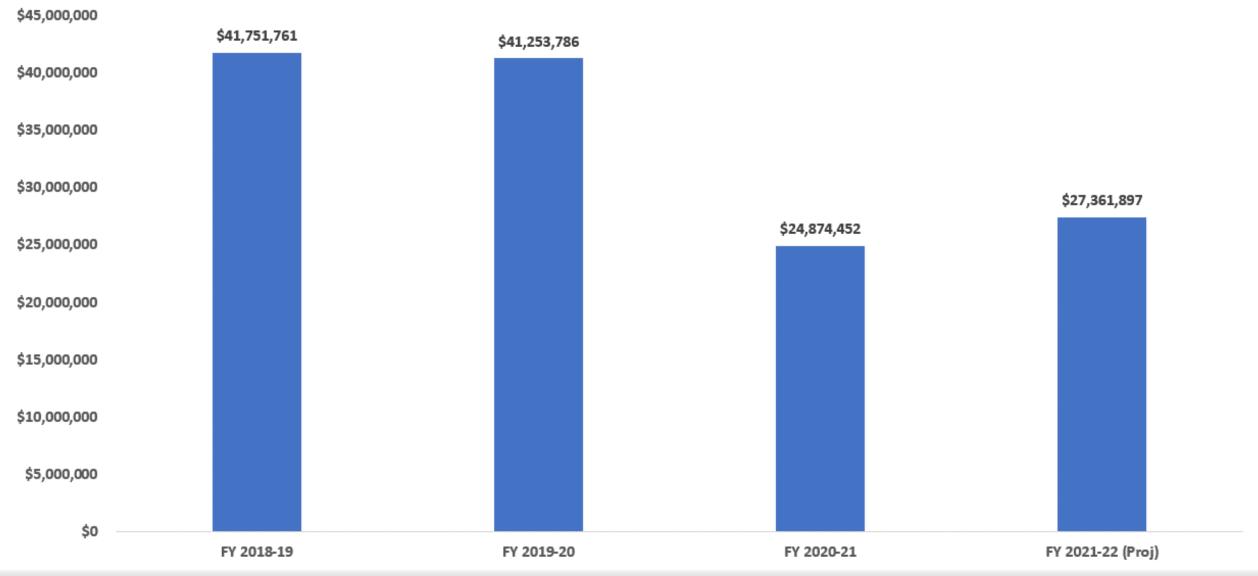
