## **OLDER AMERICANS MONTH**

**WHEREAS**, San Mateo County has a rapidly growing population of older Americans in the community; and

**WHEREAS**, San Mateo County includes Older Americans who continue to richly contribute to our community, they are leaders and trailblazers of our community; and

WHEREAS, we acknowledge that what it means "to age" has changed-for the better; and

**WHEREAS**, San Mateo County is committed to supporting older adults as they take charge of their health, explore new opportunities and activities and focus on independence; and

**WHEREAS**, San Mateo County has supported and administered programs for our older adults during the COVID-19 pandemic such as the Great Plates Delivered Program to address food insecurity being faced by those sheltering in place; and

**WHEREAS**, San Mateo County is acknowledging and involving all individuals in redefining aging in our community and supporting the efforts for cities to become "age friendly,"; and

**WHEREAS**, San Mateo County is promoting home and community-based services that support independent living; and

**WHEREAS**, San Mateo County acknowledges and promotes the state Master Plan for Aging as a blueprint to create communities where older adult Americans are valued, engaged and afforded equitable opportunity to thrive as they age; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of Older Americans month is to highlight the unique contributions of older adults to our local San Mateo community, state, and nation, while acknowledging the responsibility of policymakers to care for this population; and
