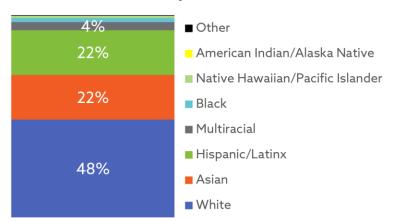

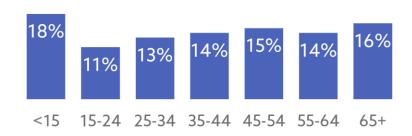

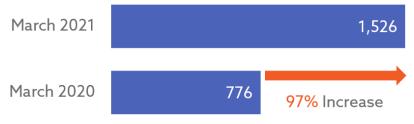






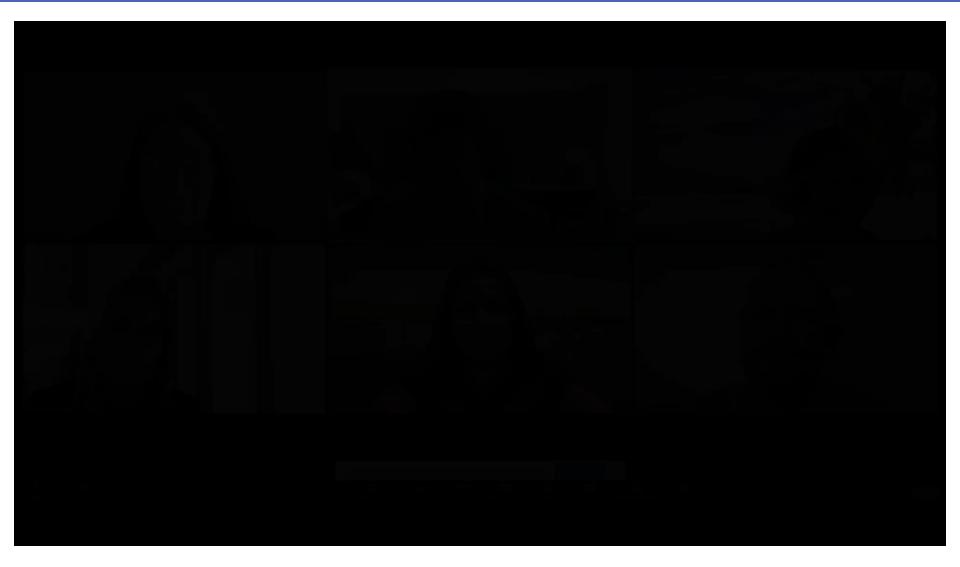


Increase in WiFi Hotspots
