To enhance the lives of children and families by helping parents meet the financial, medical and emotional needs of their children by establishing and enforcing child support orders.

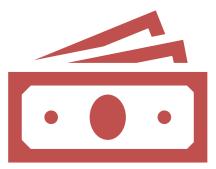

 SB80 2019 - Enacted New Funding Methodology for California Child Support Program based on Caseload to Full Time Equivalent



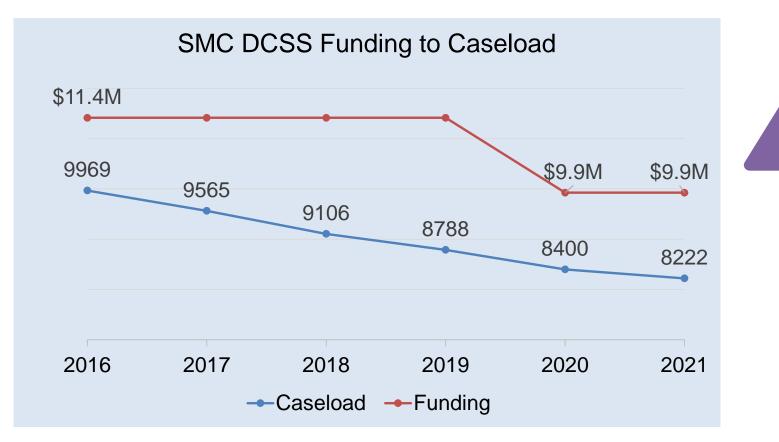
- Statewide Caseload Ratio set at 187:1
- 2020 budget allocation reduction of \$1.5 million (14%)

#### Priorities

- Conduct gap analysis and organizational restructure
- Provide critical services to the public
- Seek equitable funding for the child support program
- Maximize collections to families

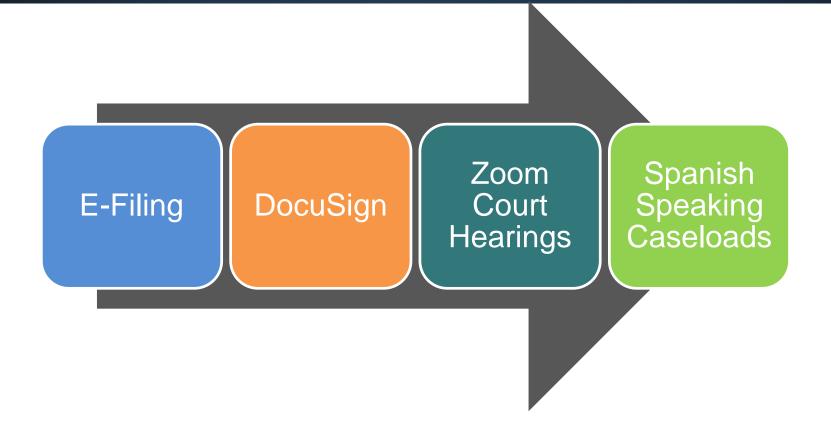

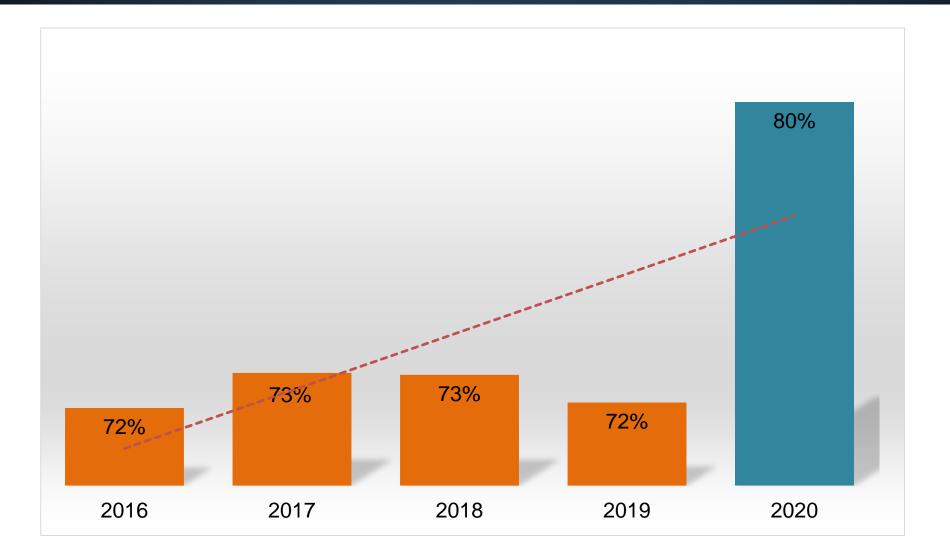

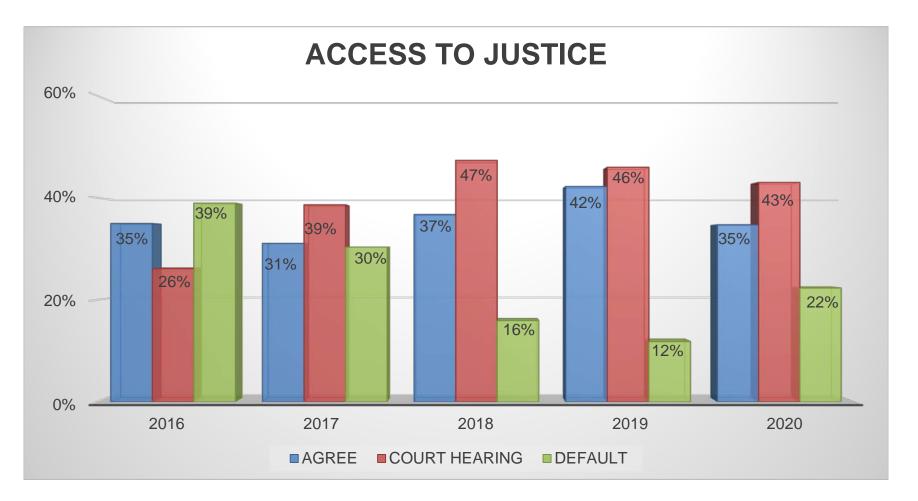
#### **Percentage of Collections on Current Support**



#### **Collections on Arrears**

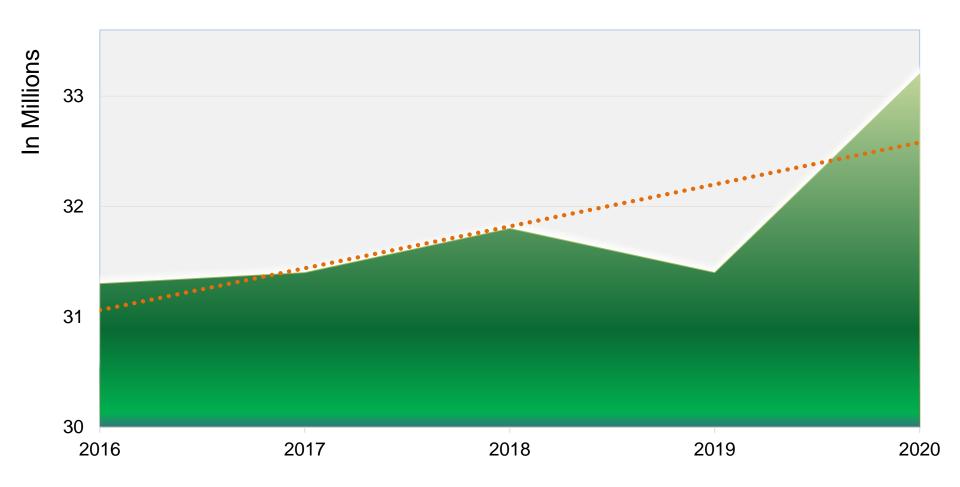
