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MEASURE K: RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH HOMEBASE/THE CENTER FOR COMMON CONCERNS, INC., FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2021 TO JUNE 30, 2024, FOR A TOTAL OBLIGATION AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$333,000 TO PROVIDE TRAINING AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Human Services Agency (HSA), in close collaboration with the County Manager's Office, the County, and community partners, coordinates the homeless crisis response system, which includes a broad spectrum of homeless services, such as homeless prevention, shelter services, and rapid re-housing programs; and

WHEREAS, on February 25, 2021, HSA released a Request for Proposals to identify a provider of a variety of planning, technical assistance, training, and grant writing services necessary to support the efforts to end homelessness in San Mateo County, and Homebase/the Center for Common Concerns, Inc. (Homebase) was awarded an agreement, based on their experience and qualifications as a training and technical assistance provider; and

WHEREAS, HSA would like to enter into an agreement with Homebase for the term of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024 for a total obligation amount not to exceed \$333,000 to provide training and technical assistance to homeless and safety net providers and other community partners to align homeless programs/services with the

guiding principles and outcomes of the new homeless system as identified by the County's Strategic Plan to End Homelessness; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of said agreement, has examined and approved it as to both form and content, and desires to enter into it.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the

President of this Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, that the Director of the Human Services Agency or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
