BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF VALLEJO FOR FORENSIC SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE FORENSIC LABORATORY FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2021, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2024, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$450,000

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Vallejo Police Department has limited staffing assigned to its Evidence Section of the Investigations Division, which handles the processing and evidence collection of all major crime scenes; and

WHEREAS, since 2006 the City of Vallejo has been contracting with the County for forensic laboratory work conducted by the Sheriff's Office Forensic Laboratory; and

WHEREAS, the use of the Sheriff's Office Forensic Laboratory will aid in more complex cases, multiple crime scenes, and any incident beyond the capabilities of the Vallejo Police Department's Evidence Section; and

WHEREAS, by providing forensic services to the City of Vallejo, an additional County position will be largely funded with the fees charged by the laboratory; and

WHEREAS, both parties now wish to enter into an agreement, whereby the County will provide specified forensic services to the City of Vallejo, for a three-year term commencing July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024, in exchange for City reimbursement to the County for an amount not to exceed \$450,000; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of such agreement and has examined and approved same as to both form and content and desires to enter into the same.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of the Board of Supervisors be, and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sheriff or Sheriff's designee is authorized to execute contract amendments and minor modifications to this agreement not to exceed an aggregate of \$25,000, and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
