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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE COUNTY'S COVID-19  
EMERGENCY SICK LEAVE IN ORDER TO EXTEND THE DATE OF APPLICATION  
TO DECEMBER 31, 2021**

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**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, state law enacted on March 19, 2021 mandates that most employers provide full time employees an additional 80 hours of COVID-19 related sick leave from January 1, 2021 to September 30, 2021; and;

**WHEREAS**, this Board previously ratified a County policy providing County employees with COVID-19 Emergency Paid Sick Leave; and

**WHEREAS**, the County's policy went beyond the minimum requirements of the law; and

**WHEREAS**, the COVID-19 pandemic continues and County employees may still require leave due to the reasons specified in the prior County of San Mateo COVID-19 Emergency Paid Sick Leave Policy; and

**WHEREAS**, the Human Resources Department has recommended an amendment extending the County's COVID-19 Emergency Sick Leave to December 31, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board has examined and approved the amendment to the Policy and its terms as to both form and content and desires to authorize the same.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the amendment to the County's COVID-19 Emergency Sick Leave to extend the date of application to December 31, 2021.

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
