**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY'S CHIEF ELECTIONS OFFICER TO  
RENDER SPECIFIED ELECTION SERVICES FOR THE MENLO PARK CITY  
SCHOOL DISTRICT AND THE TOWN OF WOODSIDE IN CONJUNCTION WITH A  
SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2021**

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, absent other arrangements or applicable law, the costs of any school district election shall be borne by the school district holding the election pursuant to Section 5421 of the Education Code, and any city or district shall reimburse the County in full for the services performed by the County's Chief Elections Officer in accordance with Division 10 of the Elections Code; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to state law, the governing board of the Menlo Park City School District adopted Resolution No. 20.21.20, giving notice of holding a special election to be held on November 2, 2021, for the purpose of submitting a parcel tax measure to District voters, and requesting the County's Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the District therefor; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to state law, the Town Council of the Town of Woodside adopted Resolution No. 2021-7423, giving notice of holding a special election to be held on November 2, 2021, for the purpose of submitting to Town of Woodside voters an initiative measure amending Woodside Municipal Code Section 153.113, and

requesting the County’s Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the Town therefor; and

**WHEREAS**, the County’s Chief Elections Officer is agreeable to providing specified election services as duly requested and enumerated above in conjunction with the special election to be held on Tuesday, November 2, 2021 (“November 2, 2021 Special Election”); and

**WHEREAS**, in consideration of the services and supplies to be provided by the County’s Chief Elections Officer in conducting the November 2, 2021 Special Election, the Menlo Park City School District and Town of Woodside, as required by law, will enter into separate agreements with the County’s Chief Elections Officer to outline the services to be rendered and to reimburse the County for the costs of said services and supplies.

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the County’s Chief Elections Officer is authorized to render specified election services for the November 2, 2021 Special Election in conjunction therewith.
