Subject: Use of District-Specific **Measure K** Funds - Supervisorial District 4

RECOMMENDATION:

Measure K: Adopt a resolution authorizing a one-time grant of district-specific **Measure K** funds, not to exceed \$37,500, to the Service League of San Mateo County for repairs and improvements to Hope House and Transitional Housing in Redwood City, and authorizing the County Manager, or his designee, to prepare and execute the grant agreement.

BACKGROUND:

Measure K is the half-cent general sales tax initially approved by San Mateo County voters in November 2012, and extended by the voters in November 2016 for a total of thirty years. The Board and County staff have conducted study sessions and community outreach efforts to inform priorities for **Measure K** spending.

On March 17, 2015, the Board adopted the **Measure A** (now **Measure K**) allocation plan for the FY 2015-17 budget, during which the County anticipates **Measure K** receipts of approximately \$80 million annually. The plan included \$5 million in one-time loans or grants for FY 2015-16, and \$1 million each year for FY 2015-16 and 2016-17, divided equally among the five supervisorial districts, for district-specific needs and projects for entities that submitted Letters of Intent which were not funded or, in cases of emergencies or unforeseen circumstances, other one-time projects for entities that did not submit a Letter of Intent. On April 28, 2015, the Board approved the criteria and process to be used by staff to administer these funds. In accordance with such criteria, District 4 submitted a request to use **Measure K** funds as shown below and in the attachment hereto:

District/Project	Amount
District 4 (Supervisor Warren Slocum) - Service League of San Mateo County: Funding to make repairs and improvements to the fencing, roof and gutters, washing machine, and stove at Hope House in Redwood City and windows, roof/gutters, washing machine, and dryer at Transitional Housing in Redwood City.	\$37,500

County Counsel has reviewed and approved the resolution as to form.

Providing funding to the Service League of San Mateo County for repairs and improvements at Hope House and Transitional Housing in Redwood City aligns with the Shared Vision 2025 outcome of a Healthy Community by providing individuals with substance use disorders with a safe place to live, recover, and re-integrate into the community.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There are sufficient **Measure K** funds budgeted in the Non-Departmental Services FY 2016-17 Adopted Budget for this purpose.
