AL18-4416	Sylvia A.K. Thompson	10/19/2018	Non-culpable Claimant alleges a San Mateo County Mosquito & Vector Control District vehicle collided with her personal vehicle and caused damage.
GL18-4432	Bryan Howell	11/20/2018	Non-culpable Claimant alleges an unmaintained water line broke and damaged residential landscape.
G18-4453	Gail Miller	11/15/2018	Non-culpable Claimant alleges she tripped on uneven pavement and fell while walking toward a County building entrance and suffered bodily injuries.

G18-4462 Alice Cutino by Debbie Hoffman under power of attorney 08/16/2018 Non-culpable
Claimant alleges bodily injuries occurred when a SamTrans bus drove over a speed bump at an excessive speed.
