Subject: Use of District-Discretionary Measure K Funds - Supervisorial District 2

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

**Measure K:** Adopt a resolution authorizing a one-time grant of district-discretionary **Measure K** funds, not to exceed \$48,270 to LifeMoves for the completion of new flooring, data server/electrical work, and new furnishings at its Vendome facility located at 415 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, San Mateo, and authorizing the County Manager or County Manager's designee, to execute the grant agreement.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

**Measure K** is the half-cent general sales tax initially approved by San Mateo County voters in November 2012 and extended in November 2016 for a total of thirty years.

On February 12, 2019, the Board of Supervisors (Board) held a study session on **Measure K** expenditures and anticipated revenue for fiscal years (FY) 2019-21. The Board-appointed a **Measure K** sub-committee, consisting of Supervisor Pine and Supervisor Canepa, which convened the study session to, among other things, work with staff to facilitate the Board's development of **Measure K** priorities and continuing initiatives for FY 2019-21. The Board approved \$3.75 million in one-time loans or grants each fiscal year for FY 2019-21, divided equally among the five supervisorial districts, for district-discretionary needs and projects. District 2 has submitted a request to use its district-discretionary **Measure K** funds as shown below and described in the Project Summary section of this memorandum:

This item is consistent with the criteria for district-discretionary **Measure K** funds approved by the Board in December 2018.

#### **PROJECT SUMMARY:**

This is a request to authorize a grant to LifeMoves, and resulting grant agreement, in an amount not to exceed \$48,270, to provide for completion of the new flooring, data server/electrical work, and new furnishings at its Vendome facility located at 415 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, San Mateo. The County Manager's Office will administer and manage the proposed agreement.

**Measure K** funding will be used to make enhancements/necessary repairs to the Vendome facility located at 415 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, San Mateo, which serves 16 homeless men and women each night in permanent supportive housing. Specifically, LiveMoves proposes to add new flooring in the hallway,

lobby, and re-configure and refurbish existing office spaces to accommodate new staff to serve the growing numbers of individuals experiencing homelessness.

## Total Measure K Request: Not to Exceed \$48,270.

The release of funds will be contingent on the execution of an agreement providing for the County's confirmation of the expenditure of funds during FY 2019-20 and 2020-21 for the purposes stated herein.
