- G21-10633 Kevin Prasad, Et Al. 04/26/2021 and Non-culpable ongoing Claimants allege their civil rights were violated while in jail custody.
- G21-10644 San Mateo Oaks 10/07/2021 Non-culpable Homeowners Association Homeowners Association alleges that the County is not maintaining a wastewater easement.
